## Inhalt und Ziele

Municipalities and regions are connected with each other in decision-making. Making administrative decisions considering neighbouring administrative units within the same nation is easier compared with considering neighboring administrative units across the national border. This is because despite the EU Cohesion Policy instruments and Single Market Act the nation border still creates obstacles for cross-border cooperation within the EU.
